Camp Acorn

Language Program Ages 2-12 **\$2,400**
Monday - Friday, 9 a.m. – noon

Offers classroom-based communication therapy with a focus on generalizing language skills and social concepts in the classroom and other settings. Our Early Childhood classes address the needs of children as young as 2 years of age. Elementary classes emphasize building the language and social skills necessary for academic success in a highly motivating, theme-based classroom environment.

Sibling Day Camp Ages 2-12 **\$1,200**
Monday - Friday, 9 a.m. – noon

Provides camp experiences for siblings of students attending our Language and Adventure Play programs. Sibling Day Camp is for children who do not require intervention for special learning needs and who fall within the typical developmental ranges for their age.

Adventure Play Ages 6-12 **\$1,600**
Monday - Friday, 9 a.m. – noon

A unique opportunity for children with or without special learning needs to engage in self-directed outdoor play and construct their own playground with the support of trained playworkers. Children create anything they can imagine using materials others may cast aside.

Extended Day Ages 2-12

Early Morning Drop-Off **\$225**
Monday - Friday, 8 – 9 a.m.

Paraeducators supervise children and escort them to their appropriate classroom when camp begins.

Afterschool Enrichment **\$600**
Monday - Thursday, noon – 3 p.m.

Led by paraeducators, afternoon enrichment offers a variety of extracurricular activities.

Camp SOCIAL Ages 8-16 **\$1,800**
July 5-10

Camp Social Superheroes and Camp Connect have combined and are now Camp SOCIAL! At this week-long sleep away camp held at Camp for All, children and teens learn and practice Social Thinking® strategies during daily social groups, connect with others, adapt to social environments, and solve social problems all while participating in fun camp activities!

Kaufman-Apraxia Boot Camp Ages 3-6 **\$3,600**
July 6 - 23 | Monday - Thursday, 9 - 11:30 a.m.

An intensive speech-language group therapy program designed to increase speech formulation, automaticity, language content and structure for children who have apraxia of speech or a severe phonological processing disorder.

Camp Super Writers Ages 5-8 **\$880**
June 2 – 11; June 15 – 25 | 4 days per week, 12:30 – 1:30 or 2:30 – 3:30
July 13 – 23 | 4 days per week, 8:30 – 9:30 or 9:30 – 10:30

A two-week intensive handwriting program, led by our Occupational Therapy team, developing handwriting skills through multi-sensory play-based instruction. Children attend group in dyads with a partner of similar age and needing similar supports. Home programs are given with ideas for follow through at home at the end of camp.

Brain Boss Ages 8 – 10 **\$630**
June 1 – July 24

Ages 8 – 10, 1 hour per week at 12 p.m. | Ages 10+, 1.5 hours per week at 3 p.m.
Sometimes checklists and reminders are not enough! In this group targeting executive functioning, children learn how to better understand time management skills while working together on chosen group projects.

Summer Social Club Ages 5-8 **\$540**
June 2-26 | Fridays, Noon – 1:30 p.m. | Wednesdays, 3:00 – 4:30
Meets once per week.

Your child will have the opportunity to practice their social competency skills, such as flexible thinking and perspective taking, while working with our SLPs who have been trained in Social Thinking® during gaming, cooking or building activities.
